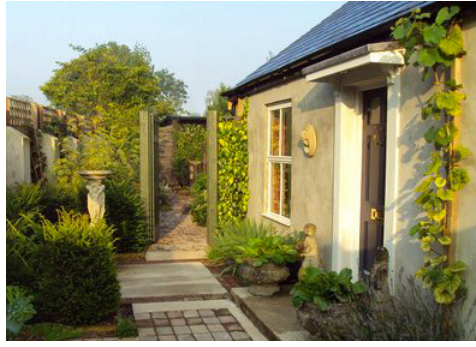


BED and BREAKFAST – Dove Cottage, Hindon, Wiltshire SP3 6EB
